### Sub: Postponement of Publication of Merit List and information regarding conduction of Test for 15 candidates

This is to inform all concerned that the date of publication of Merit List for Admission in Diploma in Engineering Courses for the Academic Session 2017-18 has been postponed due to administrative issues and the same is expected to be published on 05-07-2017 (Wednesday).

During preparation of the Merit List, the following will be considered:

1. The percentage of total aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered first.
2. If the percentage of total aggregate marks obtained is same for more than 01(One) candidate, then the percentage of marks and/or grade of subjects in the following order will be considered:  
Mathematics, Science, English, Social Science/History & Geography, 2<sup>nd</sup> Language.

While preparing the merit list, it has been observed that the below listed candidates are having same percentage/grade of marks in aggregate as well as all the compulsory subjects of the qualifying exam and so it has been decided that a written test will be conducted on **04-07-2017(Tuesday)** at NIELIT Agartala for the following group of candidates to break the ties.

The details of the written test **only for the above listed candidates** will be as follows:

1. Date & Time: **04-07-2017 (Tuesday), 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM**
2. Venue: NIELIT Agartala Centre, R. K. Nagar, Khayerpur, Agartala
3. Syllabus: Syllabus of Mathematics and Science followed by CBSE for Secondary Examination
4. Total Marks (60 Marks):  
Mathematics: 30 Marks (10 Marks Objective, 20 Marks Subjective)  
Science : 30 Marks (10 Marks Objective, 20 Marks Subjective)
5. The tie at the merit positions will be attempted to be broken based on the performance of the candidates in the test.
6. If a candidate remains absent, then he/she will be given 0(zero) marks in the written test.
7. The merit list will be prepared after the written test and the following will be considered
  - 7.1 The total marks obtained in the written test will be considered first
  - 7.2 If the total marks obtained in the written test is same for more than 01 candidate, then the marks of the Mathematics will be considered.
  - 7.3 If the total marks obtained in the written test and the marks obtained in Mathematics are same for more than 01 candidate, then a lottery will be conducted after the examination and the tie will be tried to be broken.
