To list files in a specific directory, pass the path to the directory as an argument to the ls command. For example, to list the contents of the /etc directory you would type type:

ls /etc

You can also pass multiple directories and files to the 1s command separated by space:

ls /etc /var /etc/passwd

If the user you are logged in doesn't have read permissions to the directory, you will get a message saying that is can't open the directory:

ls /root

ls: cannot open directory '/root': Permission denied
