

Substituting or replacing the nth occurrence in a line

If you want to replace the second string occurrence in a line, use the /2 flag as shown.

```
#sed 's/Linux/Unix/2' linuxgeek.txt
```

Output

```
root@ubuntu:~# sed 's/Linux/Unix/2' linuxgeek.txt
Linux is a free and opensource operating system. Unix is a powerful OS.
Linux is also a multi user system. Many software developers code on Unix.
Linux comes in many flavors.
With Linux you can accomplish administrative tasks without much hassle.
Linux is easy to learn. So don't get scared. Welcome to Unix !
```
