

# Linux whoami command - Knowing Who is Logged In

Generally, on your terminal you will find a **username is printed** on the command prompt. But in some shell such as **csh**, by default you will not see your username there. So this command particularly is used with the shell which don't print the username on their shell.

To run this command, just type **whoami**. For this sample we are using csh shell.

```
% whoami
```

```
~/ whoami  
pungki  
~/ _
```
