CSS – Its Types

There are following three types of CSS:

Inline CSS
 Internal CSS
 External CSS

The type of CSS is actually concerned with how we add or insert the CSS code into HTML document.

- Inline CSS is used to apply CSS on single element. It is written as value using style attribute of element/tag.
- **Internal** CSS is used to apply CSS on a single document or page. It is written inside the <style> ...</style> tag within head section of html.
- External CSS is used to apply CSS on multiple pages. The CSS code is written in a CSS file (.css) and then included/linked in HTML documents.



Inline CSS

It is defined by writing CSS code as the value using style attribute of element.

1. To style a paragraph, use inline CSS as follows:

```
Paragraph 1
```

2. To style a heading, use inline CSS as follows:

```
<h1 style="color:white; background-color:green;">Heading 1 </h1>
```

4 Internal CSS

It is defined by writing CSS code inside the <style> ...</style> tag within head section of html.


```

p {
color:white;
background-color:blue;
}
h1 {
color:white;
background-color:green;
}
</style>
```

Note: So far in earlier lectures of CSS, Internal CSS is used in every example. You are supposed to very much familiar that how Internal CSS is used.

CSS styles are applied to only those elements where these are written using style attribute of element.

CSS styles are applied to all elements of the page for which these are specified using <style> .. </style> tag in head section.
