

<u>Tags of Lists</u>: Lists are like vertical representation of many items from top to bottom. In HTML lists are of following two types-

- 1. Unordered Lists (UL)
- 2. Ordered Lists (OL)

Unordered Lists: In unordered lists, items start from bullets.




Attributes:

• <u>type:</u> it is used with to specify the type of bullet. It's possible values aredisc / square / circle.

Ordered Lists: In ordered lists, items start from numerals.

Attributes:

• **type:** it is used with to specify the type of numeral. It's values are-1 / a / A / i. **NOTE:** The default type in <UL> is "disc" whereas in <OL> it is "1".
