

Tags of Lists: Lists are like vertical representation of many items from top to bottom. In HTML lists are of following two types-

- 1.** Unordered Lists (UL)
- 2.** Ordered Lists (OL)

Unordered Lists: In unordered lists, items start from bullets.

Syntax:

```
<ul>
  <li>India</li>
  <li>Pakistan</li>
  <li>Sri Lanka</li>
  <li>Bangladesh</li>
</ul>
```

Output:

- India
- Pakistan
- Sri Lanka
- Bangladesh

Attributes:

- **type:** it is used with to specify the type of bullet. It's possible values are- disc / square / circle.

Ordered Lists: In ordered lists, items start from numerals.

Syntax:

```
<ol>
  <li>India</li>
  <li>Pakistan</li>
  <li>Sri Lanka</li>
  <li>Bangladesh</li>
</ol>
```

Output:

1. India
2. Pakistan
3. Sri Lanka
4. Bangladesh

Attributes:

- **type:** it is used with to specify the type of numeral. It's values are- 1 / a / A / i.

NOTE: The default type in is "disc" whereas in it is "1".
