NOTE:

- 1. As in the second syntax, <u>background-repeat</u> has been used with <u>repeat-x</u>, <u>repeat-y</u> would have repeated the image vertically. Similarly <u>repeat-xy</u> would have repeated the image on entire background. A <u>no-repeat</u> does not repeat the image.
- **<u>2.</u>** <u>background-attachment</u> works on the contents like-headings, paragraphs, images etc. whether to scroll with background or without background.

<u>3.</u> <u>background-position</u> positions the image on the background. It is always used with <u>background-repeat: no-repeat</u>.
