

CSS on Body:

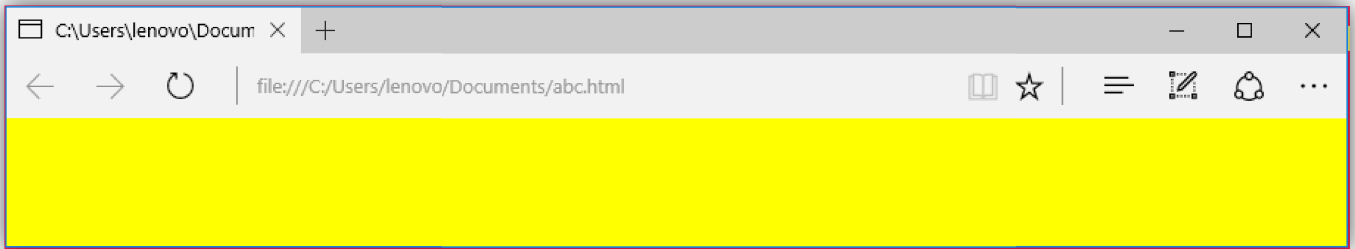
CSS designs the <body> element in the following ways-

<u>Property</u>	<u>Value</u>	<u>Description</u>
background-color	Red; / #ff0000; / rgb(255,0,0);	Colors the background
background-image	url("paper.gif");	Puts a background image
background-repeat	repeat-x;	Repeats the image horizontally
	repeat-y;	Repeats the image Vertically
	repeat-xy;	Repeats the image entirely
	no-repeat;	Does not repeat the image
background-attachment	fixed;	Background does not scroll
	scroll;	Background scrolls
background-position	top; / left; / bottom; / right;	Position of the background image

Syntax [background-color]:

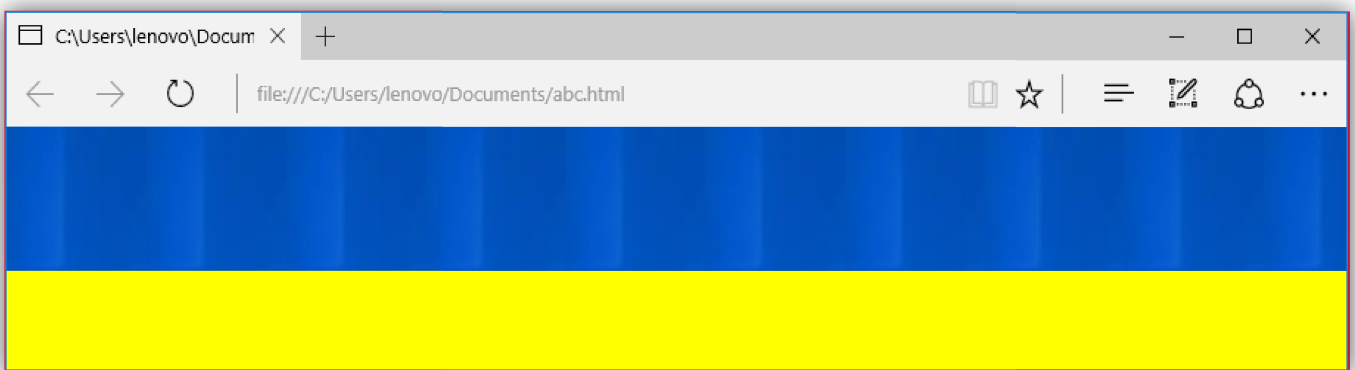
Output:



Syntax [background-image]:

```
<html>
  <head>
    <style>
      body
      {
        background-color:yellow;
        background-image:url ('img1.jpg');
        background-repeat:repeat-x;
      }
    </style>
  </head>
  <body>
  </body>
</html>
```

Output:



NOTE:

1. As in the second syntax, background-repeat has been used with repeat-x, repeat-y would have repeated the image vertically. Similarly repeat-xy would have repeated the image on entire background. A no-repeat does not repeat the image.
2. background-attachment works on the contents like-headings, paragraphs, images etc. whether to scroll with background or without background.

3. background-position positions the image on the background. It is always used with background-repeat: no-repeat.
