list-style-type	None; / circle; / disc; / square;	ul	List styles in UL

list-style-image	url('sqpurple.gif');	ul	Image as list style
list-style-position	outside; / inside;	ul , ol	Position of list
background-color	#4CAF50;	ul , ol	Background color of list elements
background-image	url("paper.gif");	ul , ol	background-image

CSS on Forms: Forms are stylized to a great extent using CSS. Consider the following properties:

States of forms in CSS:

- **Hover on element**: Elements are highlighted when mouse is hovered on.

```
input: hover {background-color: #f5f5f5; }
```

- **Focus on Element**: Elements are highlighted when mouse is clicked on.

```
input: focus {background-color: #f5f5f5; }
```
