

The scope of this laboratory project covers multiple advanced fields-Robotics, IoT, Cloud, and LMS-which generally require specialized expertise from different domains. Restricting participation to a single vendor OEM may significantly limit competition and exclude many capable solution providers. Allowing JV/Consortium participation will: Encourage open and fair participation. Enable bidders to bring together domain experts from different fields (Robotics, IOT, Cloud Solution, Learning Management Systems). Ensure the best possible technical and academic outcomes for the end-users. We therefore request your kind confirmation and clarification on whether Joint Ventures or Consortia are eligible.</p>	As per tender document
2.	<p>Received on GeM Portal</p> <p>With reference to the Bidder Eligibility Criteria in the tender document, it is mentioned that "Bidder should have Cloud Based IoT Labs / Centre of Excellence in Education Institutes." We request your kind clarification on the following: Kindly confirm whether experience establishing Robotics Labs, IoT Labs, Automation Labs, Artificial Intelligence Labs, Mechatronics Labs, or other Educational Training Labs in institute will also be considered as valid and relevant experience under this clause. The current eligibility clause, if limited only to Cloud-Based IoT Labs, may inadvertently favour very specific bidder or OEMs. Considering the objectives of promoting fair competition and wider participation, we request that the eligibility be broadened to include bidders with proven experience in Educational Training Labs in the above-mentioned domains. 3.	<p>Received on GeM Portal</p> <p>With reference to the tender document, Serial No. 6 (Multifunction Industrial Robot – On Time Cost), we seek your kind clarification on the following point: As per the specification, it is mentioned that “One Robotics System with Eight Subsystems”, where the subsystems include: Vision System 2D Path Following Voice Command Colour Sensing Material Sensing Palletising Magnetic Pick and Place Logistic Sorting System. However, under the Quantity column, the total quantity is specified as 8(Eight). We request clarification whether this implies: A total of 8 complete robotic systems are required, with each system comprising all the above 8 subsystems, OR A total of 1 robotic system is required, but with 8 different subsystems (one each as listed). Industrial Robots are very high-value products, and such a requirement significantly affects cost estimation.</p>	<p>One set of 08 robots/systems.</p> <p>Wherein each robot/system will have capacity to perform one task out of given list of 08 tasks.</p>


