BCA courses are conducted in five Centres at Guwahati, Tezpur, Jorhat, Kokrajhar, and Dibrugarh, affiliated with ASTU the government of Assam and approved by AICTE. We also conduct MSc (Computer Science) under ASTU at Guwahati.

During 2024-25, a total of 21,534 candidates were trained in various courses, including formal, long-term, and short-term courses. Some highlights are training of school students of Kendriya Vidyalaya(KV) and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) and training of police personals in cyber security. 3031 students of KV and 381 of JNV students were trained in emerging technologies of AI and IoT. Moreover 802 police personals were trained in cyber security.

We are associated with around 60+ academic institutions and provide "skilling courses" to youths in most of the districts of the State. Our commitment to the welfare of the region and the country is unwavering. We are open to suggestions that can further enhance our efforts in re-skilling and empowering the youth and other areas of improvement. 1. ABOUT NIELIT

National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT), (erstwhile DOEACC Society), an Autonomous Scientific Society under the administrative control of Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, was set up to carry out Human Resource Development and related activities in the area of Information, Electronics & Communications Technology (IECT). NIELIT is engaged both in Formal & Non-Formal Education in the area of IECT besides development of industry oriented quality education and training programmes in the state-of-the-art areas. NIELIT has endeavoured to establish standards to be the country's premier institution for Examination and Certification in the field of IECT. It is also one of the National Examination Body, which accredits institutes/organizations for conducting courses in IT in the non-formal sector.

NIELIT has Fifty (55) centers out of which 22 centres in NE region of the country with its Headquarters at New Delhi. It is also well networked throughout India with the presence of about 700 + institutes and approximately 9,000 facilitation centers delivering digital competency training.

Over the last two decades, NIELIT has acquired very good expertise in IT training, through its wide repertoire of courses, ranging from 'O' Level (Foundation), 'A' Level (Advance Diploma), 'B' Level (MCA equivalent), 'C' Level (M-Tech level), IT literacy courses such as CCC (Course on Computer Concept), BCC (Basic Computer Course) and other long term and short term course in the non-formal sector like courses on Information Security, ITeS-BPO (Customer Care/Banking), Computer Hardware Maintenance (CHM-O/A level), Bio-Informatics (BI-O/A/B level), ESDM etc, besides, high-end courses offered by NIELIT Centres at Post-Graduate level (M.Tech) in Electronics Design & Technology, Embedded Systems etc. which are not normally offered by Universities/Institutions in the formal sector, in association with the respective state Universities.

The basket of activities of NIELIT is further augmented by the wide range of projects that it undertakes. NIELIT has demonstrated its capability and capacity to undertake R&D projects, consultancy services, turnkey projects in office automation, software development, website development etc.

NIELIT as a Deemed-to-be University: In a landmark achievement, NIELIT has been conferred the status of a Deemed-to-be University (de-novo) through Gazette Notification No. 9-3/2023-U.3(A) dated July 15, 2024, as published in Part I, Section 1 of the Gazette of India. The primary campus of the university is located in Ropar, Punjab, with 11 constituent units situated in Aizawl, Agartala, Aurangabad, Calicut, Gorakhpur, Imphal, Kohima, Patna, Srinagar, Kekri, and Itanagar. The constituent units are being expanded to include other centres as well.

2. ABOUT NIELIT CENTRES IN ASSAM/GUWAHATI



2.1. NIELIT Guwahati

National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), Guwahati is an autonomous scientific society under the administrative control of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India. The first centre as CEDTI (Centre for Electronics Design and Technology, India)) was set up at Tezpur by the then Department of Information Technology (DIT) in 1998. The Guwahati Centre was established in the year 2002 as CEDTI to bridge the gap between the academic institutions and industries and later it was merged with DOEACC Society and was renamed as DOEACC Centre Guwahati. In the year 2011, it was renamed as NIELIT. Currently, it has five Extension Centres in Assam at Dibrugarh, Jorhat, Kokrajhar, Silchar, and Tezpur, and one Study Centre at Majuli. The Administrative and Academic activities of all the Centers in Assam are controlled by NIELIT Guwahati Centre.

NIELIT Guwahati Centre and its Extension Centres are engaged in teaching different formal, short-term and long-term courses in IT, Electronics, and in the area of Bioinformatics. The Centre offers many skill-based job-oriented courses to the youths of the state, which are approved by the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF). NIELIT is actively engaged in Capacity Building and Skill Development in the areas of IECT such as Future Skills, Cyber Law; Cyber Security; Cloud Computing and related verticals.

NIELIT is also rolling out Digital Competency Programmes for many State Governments for its employees and the masses. NIELIT is functioning under the overall control and guidance of the Governing Council. The Hon'ble Union Minister for Electronics and Information Technology (E&IT) is the chairperson of the Council whereas Hon'ble MoS (E&IT) is the Deputy Chairperson with its members from Government, Industry, Academia and representatives of various professional bodies. NIELIT Guwahati is one of the Centre of NIELIT and functions at seven locations at Guwahati (Khanapara), Jorhat, Dibrugarh, Tezpur, Kokrajhar, Silchar, and Majuli in the state of Assam.

The National Policy on Skill Development is aimed towards empowering all individuals through improved skills, knowledge and nationally and internationally recognized qualifications to gain access to decent employment and to ensure India's competitiveness in the global market. NIELIT plays an important role in skilling of youth in the area of IECT.

The wide repertoire of NIELIT Courses includes:

In addition, NIELIT has also created expertise for the roll out of customized skilling, upskilling and reskilling programmes as per specific needs of public and private sector firms.

2.2. Tezpur Extension Centre

Tezpur extension centre of NIELIT Guwahati” is in operation w.e.f. 5th August’1998, in the name & style of “CEDTI Tezpur” after signing of an MOU between Tezpur University & erstwhile Dept. of Electronics, Govt. of India. The centre started its operations from the Tezpur University campus. Subsequently as per decision of the Executive Committee meeting held on 18-7-2002, the CEDTI, Tezpur has been re-named as “CEDTI, North East (Upper)” with area of operation extending to the states of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya and Sikkim and to initially function from Guwahati and Tezpur with administrative set up at Guwahati.

2.3. Jorhat Extension Centre

The 3.3 acre permanent campus of NIELIT Jorhat Extension Centre is situated in Rowriah under Khongia Mouza of Jorhat West Revenue Circle. Although the extension centre has been operational from rented premises since August 2013, it was formally inaugurated by Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar, Hon'ble MoS, MeitY, Govt of India on the 6th of May, 2022.

NIELIT Jorhat Extension Centre has been in the fore-front of providing up-to-date industry relevant training programs in the field of Information, Electronics and Communication technology (IECT) in the non-formal sector. Together with state-of-the art infrastructure and an ambience conducive to learning and development, the extension centre ranks among the best training centre in entire upper Assam. The centre is at a distance of 3.2 km from Jorhat Airport and 8.4 km from Jorhat railway station.

The state-of-the-art infrastructure of NIELIT Jorhat Extension Centre includes 2 air-conditioned software labs, a hardware lab, a smart classroom and 2 classrooms with projectors and whiteboards for imparting trainings. Besides these, the centre is also equipped with an air-conditioned conference room with video conferencing facility and a fully air-conditioned auditorium with smart LCD system capable of seating 50 persons.

Besides the infrastructure it also boasts of excellent faculty members who are highly qualified, efficient, dedicated, and knowledgeable, and committed to providing the best to the trainees. As a consequence, the NIELIT-Jorhat Extension Centre is one of the presently prevailed extension Centres of NIELIT Guwahati which is an autonomous scientific society of MeitY, Govt. of India.

2.5. Dibrugarh Extension Centre

The Dibrugarh Extension Centre is one of the five extension centres under NIELIT Guwahati (formerly DOEACC Society), an autonomous scientific society under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India. Located at its own campus in Melengial Gaon, Moderkhat, Near Sessa Park, Dibrugarh Extension Centre is positioned 11 km from Dibrugarh Railway Station (Banipur) and 8.8 km from Mohanbari Airport. The centre is well-connected by bus, train, and air, making it easily accessible. Situated 439 km (273 miles) east of Guwahati, the capital of Assam, the centre is surrounded by industries specializing in tea production, oil and natural gas, power generation, and fertilizers. Primary mandate of NIELIT Dibrugarh EC is to provide industry-relevant training programs in the areas of Information, Electronics, and Communication Technology (IECT) and to offer quality education in Electronics and Information Technology through state-of-the-art infrastructure and equipment

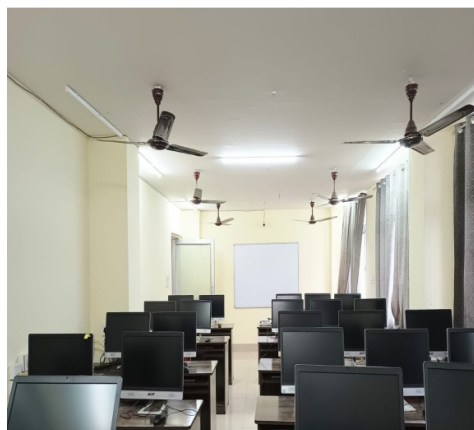

2.7. Majuli Study Centre

NIELIT Majuli Study Centre was established in June 2018 with an aim to deliver up to date industry relevant training programs in the areas of Information, Electronics & Communication Technology (IECT) to the youths of this region and thereby make them eligible and confident to earn their livelihood in this changing environment. The centre has the state of the art facility with labs and internet connectivity to deliver the best education to the youths of far flung areas of the island. Besides it will also cater to the modern technical educational needs of the neighbouring districts of North Lakhimpur, Dhemaji, ViswanathChariali etc. on the north bank of the Brahmaputra.

The NIELIT Majuli Study Centre has trained around 1000 students and youths mainly from rural background since its inception in various long and short term courses in the field of ICT Courses like CCC, Digital marketing, basics of IOT, etc. have instilled confidence in the youths to gain their livelihood either in the public/private sector or through entrepreneurship. Also plans are afoot to setup a full fledged NIELIT Centre at Majuli which will cater to the modern ICT technical needs of the region including the three north bank districts of Dhemaji, Lakhimpur and Biswanath.

18. ELIGIBILITY FOR BCA and MSc(CS)

18.1. Eligibility Criteria for BCA

- 10+2 passed in Science/Arts/Commerce with a minimum of 45% in aggregate (40% for reserved category) *preferably* with Computer Science/ Mathematics as a subject in 10+2 OR
- Diploma Engineering from AICTE recognized institute (As per ASTU norms).

18.2. Eligibility Criteria for M.Sc. Computer Science

- Bachelor degree in Computer Science/Information Technology(B.ScCS/IT) OR
- Bachelor degree in Computer Application(BCA) OR
- Bachelor degree in Science with *Mathematics* as one of the subject in 10+2 or in degree level OR
- 4- year Bachelor degree in Engineering/Technology (BE/B.Tech.) OR
- DOEACC 'A' level course after passing Bachelor degree OR
- B.Sc. with PGDCA.
- Minimum eligibility marks to take admission will be 50% (45% for reserved category) OR equivalent grade in a point scale whenever grading system is followed (As per ASTU norms).

After last date of admission, vacant seats under reserved category will be filled up from the waiting list irrespective of category

19. HOW TO APPLY FOR BCA & MSc(CS)

- **For BCA**, the application will be online through the common admission portal only. Candidate has to complete the form submission by submitting details and uploading necessary documents. (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>).
- **For MSc(CS)**, students are to submit the application form offline/online.
- If required, admission test or interview may be conducted.
- Selected candidates will have to take admission within stipulated date & time and vacant seats (if any) will be allotted to candidates of the waiting list on first-come-first-serve basis.
- Last date of submission of online/offline application and admission will be generally as per the Notifications of Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Assam and ASTU. *However, NIELIT Guwahati may set or extend the dates as required.*

20. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS OF THE CENTRE

1. Principles :

This code of conduct has been formulated to provide a clear statement of the Centre's expectations with respect to students in respect of academic matters and personal behavior. NIELIT, Guwahati recognizes and values the diversity of students' experiences and expectations, and is committed to treating students, both academically and personally

in a fair and transparent manner. All students in return, are required to comply both the requirements set down in this code of conduct.

2. Coverage :

This code of conduct applies to all full and part-time students of NIELIT Guwahati, in respect of all actions and activities relating to or impacting on the NIELIT Guwahati or its students and employees.

3. Definitions :

In this code of conduct, **student** means all full and part-time students whose names are enrolled at NIELIT Guwahati. **Employee** means all officers and staff of NIELIT Guwahati (including full time & part time Faculty / employees, Contract Employees, Lab Assistants, Casual staff), and Employees from other organizations, working for the Centre.

4. Personal Conduct :

All students must

- 4.1 Treat all employees (as defined above) with respect, dignity, impartiality, courtesy and sensitivity.
- 4.2 Maintain a co-operative and collaborative approach to interpersonal relationship.
- 4.3 Ensure that they do not act in a manner that unnecessarily or unreasonably impedes the ability of other students, employees and vendors working with the Centre.
- 4.4 Ensure that they do not become involved in or encourage discrimination against or harassment of employees or other students.

5. General Rules and Code of Conduct for Students :

In keeping with the tradition of the institution, all student of NIELIT Guwahati are required to maintain discipline and decorum in the building / campus and refrain from any activity that can tarnish the reputation of the institution. Violation of this will result in inviting appropriate disciplinary action. Following rules are to be strictly maintained by the students:

- 5.1 Avoid any activity or behavior that unfairly provide advantage or disadvantage to any student academically.
- 5.2 Read necessary official correspondences, meant for students, at the Notice Board on a regular basis.
- 5.3 Online Registration for all Long term & Short term courses are periodically updated in the website (www.nielit.gov.in). All students must register themselves within the schedule. Clear all the fees within scheduled time to avoid any embarrassment and / or penal action.
- 5.4 Record complaints, if any, in the concerned Register lying with the Reception. Authority will see to solve them as far as practicable at the earliest. They can not disturb activities of the Centre, faculty or others with their complaints. They can meet Teaching Staff, Coordinator or others with prior appointment only for explaining their views in a cordial way.
- 5.5 Speaking loudly, using microphones within the Centre / Campus, indecent language or behavior, sitting on a desk or using the chair of the faculty, writing indecent and / or objectionable things on board in the absence of faculty, damaging assets of the Centre are not allowed. Violation of the guidelines will attract penalty including suspension of students.
- 5.6 Ragging in any form or time is banned in the Centre.
- 5.7 Smoking and use of alcohol are strictly prohibited.
- 5.8 All students are required to maintain the environment clean and not to litter the building & campus.

- 5.9 Identity Card should always be kept by the students and produce on demand by the Security. Non-production of the same will lead to suitable action.
- 5.10 Pasting posters and / or writing on classroom walls / corridor walls, doors, windows, toilets, are strictly banned.
- 5.11 Indulging in any act of sexual harassment of any student is strictly prohibited, and it may be reported to Disciplinary committee and then to Police stations.
- 5.12 Bringing any political or other influence in a matter pertaining to a student's career, fees concession / waiver or any other favour not allowed.
- 5.13 Strike, Picketing, Gherao are totally banned in the Institute. Any such act may attract appropriate penal action.
- 5.14 Using Mobile Phone or equivalent in the Classroom / Lab will not be allowed. These are to be switched off while entering the classroom or lab. If any student is found using the same or it is heard ringing while class / lab are going, it will be forfeited.

6. Laboratories :

- 6.1 All students are required to attend laboratory classes as per schedule, and the Centre is not liable to compensate any absence due to reason whatsoever.
- 6.2 Students should enter Lab and use equipment as per schedule. They will not be allowed other than schedule time in the Lab under any circumstances.
- 6.3 Lab Records should be brought, and instructions should be followed accordingly.
- 6.4 A congenial atmosphere should be maintained in the Laboratory Classes.
- 6.5 Misbehavior with Students / Staff is not allowed in any circumstances in Lab / Classroom / Centre Premises and will be seriously dealt with.
- 6.6 Use of any personal media / equipment like CD, Pen Drive, etc. will not be allowed.
- 6.7 Use of internet for a purpose other than academic or career advancement related activities is banned. Viewing Pornographic Sites or sites playing against social and national interest will be treated as a very serious offense.

7. Examination :

- 7.1 Malpractice of any kind will not be allowed during all the Theory / Practical Examinations conducted at the Centre round the year.
- 7.2 Students who indulge in copying from neighbors with Papers Bits / Books / Notes / Calculators, etc., will be severely dealt with.
- 7.3 Students cannot carry any mobile phone or equivalent in the examination hall. If any student is found using the same or heard them ringing during examination inside the examination hall, he / she will be expelled from the rest of the examination period and the equipment will be forfeited.
- 7.4 All NIELIT (DOEACC) Examinations are conducted by an independent body managed by a Committee. The Committee is represented by Professionals from different Academic Institutes / Universities / Centre of Excellence. The committee looks after the day-to-day activities of the system. It cannot be controlled nor has been formed to control for someone's benefit but to manage the Examination in a fair way and in an unbiased manner.
- 7.5 Any student can move only forward his / her view(s) through the respective Wing Heads to the Centre Head who may forward them to the Examination Committee for its consideration, but such forwarding does not guarantee the implementation of the observations. The committee has the liberty to consider / reject the observations based on the merit of each such case.

- 7.6 The Course Coordination Group may conduct internal examination for improvement of the students and reduce communication gaps between students & faculty members with respect to teaching.
- 7.7 The Venue of Examination, the Examination Supervisor, Conductance of Examination, etc. is totally controlled by the Examination Committee, and the Centre has no right to make any addition / alteration to them.
