Introduction to NIELIT

The National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT) is the **skill development and manpower augmentation arm** of the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, for Information, Electronics & Communication Technologies (IECT). NIELIT has a network of more than 50 Centres/Extension Centres, more than 700 Accredited Training Partners (ATPs), and over 9000 Facilitation Centres to deliver training programs.

NIELIT Delhi empowers individuals in the Delhi/NCR region with job-oriented and industry-aligned courses in Information Technology and Electronics. These courses equip learners with the necessary skills to leverage technology for their personal and professional growth.

NIELIT & Skill India Mission

NIELIT plays a vital role in the Government's Skill India Mission. Introduction to National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF)

The NSQF is a competency-based framework that organizes qualifications according to levels of knowledge, skills, and aptitude. It recognizes prior learning and promotes lifelong learning. The NSQF creates a dual system, providing more youth with skilling opportunities. Over 100 countries have adopted or are developing similar frameworks.

The NSQF resolves issues related to:

- Lack of uniformity in qualifications
- Equivalence of Degrees/Diplomas/Certificates

This promotes better employability and mobility for students. The NSQF framework ensures individuals acquire the desired competencies and are rewarded for acquiring additional skills, leading to more career and entrepreneurial opportunities.

NIELIT's NSQF Accreditation Scheme

NIELIT offers accreditation for a range of NSQF-aligned courses available at <https://nielit.gov.in/content/nsqf> to support the Skill India Mission and enhance the quality of skill education in India, aligning it with international standards. These courses are of varying durations and levels and all details are listed on the National Qualification Register available at <https://www.nqr.gov.in/>. Institutes/colleges can apply for accreditation to deliver these programs on their campuses. NIELIT conducts all examinations and do certifications of the NIELIT NSQF Courses.

Also, Institutions accredited by NIELIT or affiliated with AICTE/Universities offering similar programs can leverage a streamlined accreditation process for these courses. They can gain accreditation based on self-certification, eliminating the need for an inspection visit for certain courses.

Accreditation Fees

Fees is charged as under:

Base Accreditation Fees: ₹ 10,000/- for one course

Plus Per Course Accreditation Fees: ₹ 5000/-

Plus Per Visit Inspection Charges: ₹ 20,000/- if applicable

Plus GST (as applicable).

e.g. an institute wishes to apply for 3 courses The Institute shall pay

Base Fees: ₹10,000/- for one course

Plus Per Course Accreditation Fees: ₹5000/- * 2 = ₹10,000 for two extra courses

Plus ₹ 20,000/- as Visit Inspection Charges if applicable as per course selected

Plus 18% GST on ₹40,000/- (₹10,000/- + ₹5,000/- + ₹5,000/- + ₹20,000/-)

An institution can apply for maximum of 10 courses initially. For the institutions/Courses, where inspection is required to be carried out, Rs.20,000/- will have to be paid additionally for visit to institutions irrespective of number of courses applied. GST as applicable has to be paid extra as applicable. All rights reserved by NIELIT. Fees and/or process may be revised by NIELIT anytime without giving any notice.

Accreditation Process

Details on courses, the accreditation process, and guidelines are available on the NIELIT website: <https://nielit.gov.in/content/nsqf>. Prospective training partners are advised to prepare necessary documents, fees, hardware & software infrastructure, and faculty arrangements before applying for accreditation.

The portal for online application for NSQF Accreditation is yet to be made operational. Till the availability of Online Portal, applications for the Delhi NCT may be sent in the prescribed format with necessary enclosures and requisite fee through Demand Draft in favour of NIELIT Delhi payable at Delhi.
