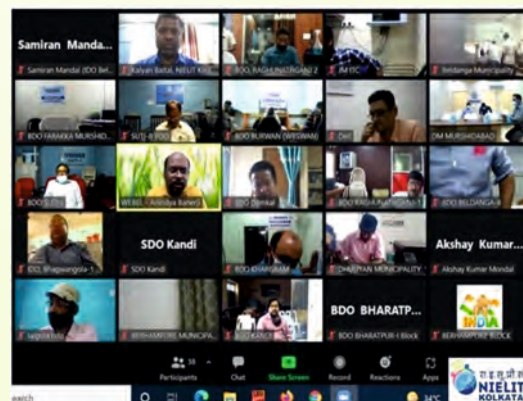
Cyber Security Training to Defence Personnel at Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh

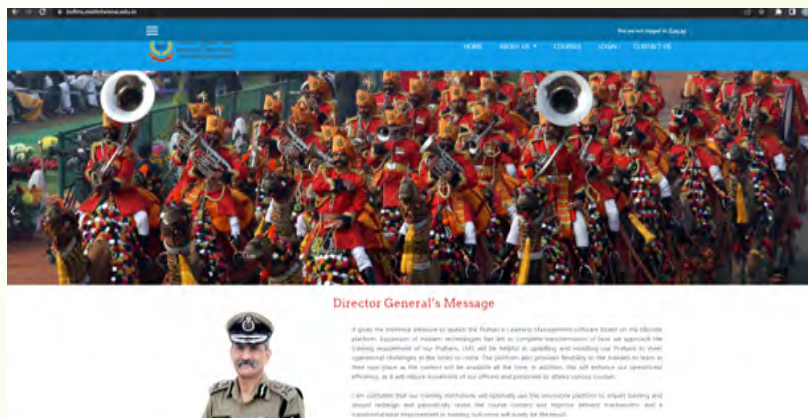


CORPORATE TRAINING/ FDPs

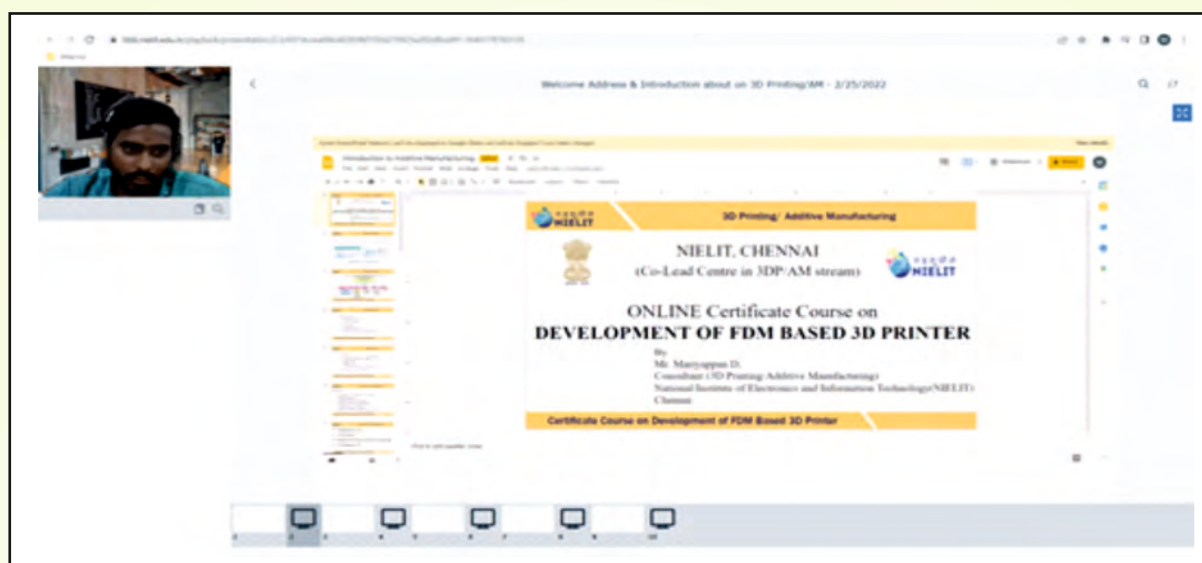

Course on Development of FDM Based 3D Printer

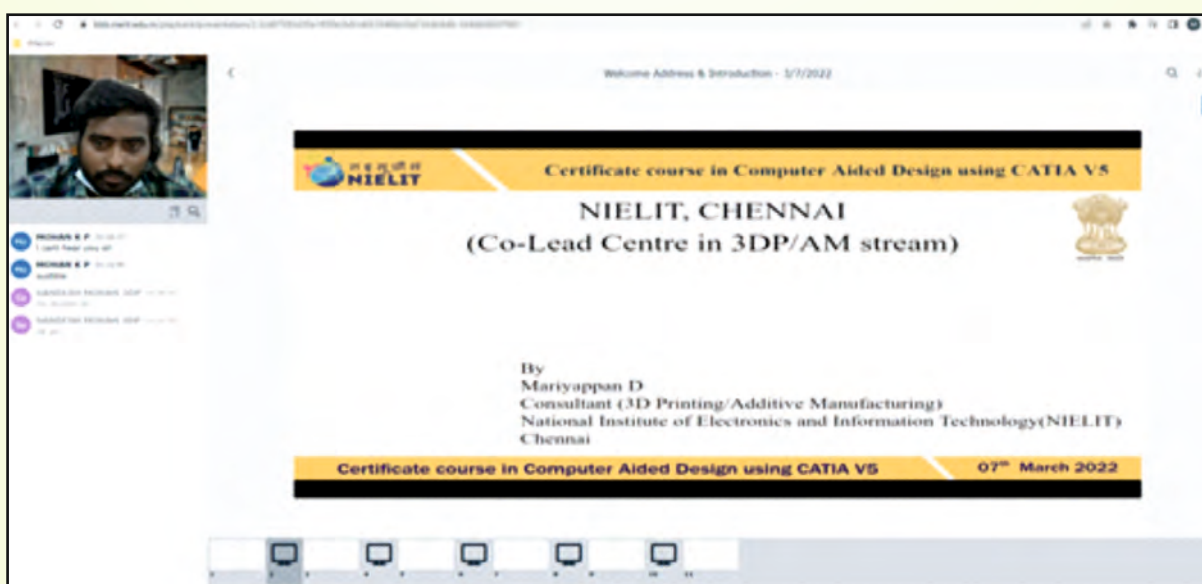

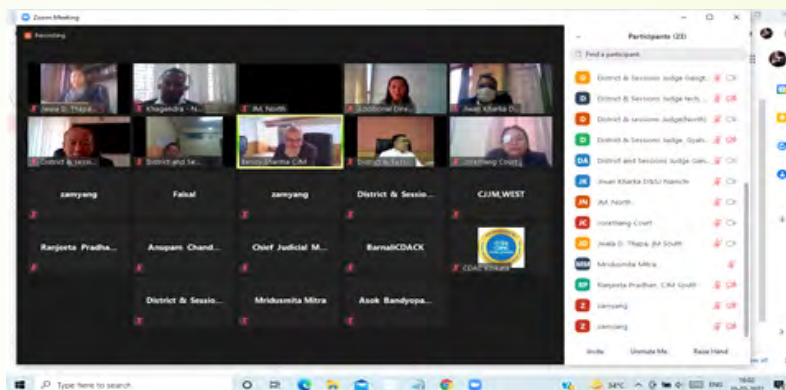
Capacity building of Law Enforcement Agency to Tackle Cybercrimes

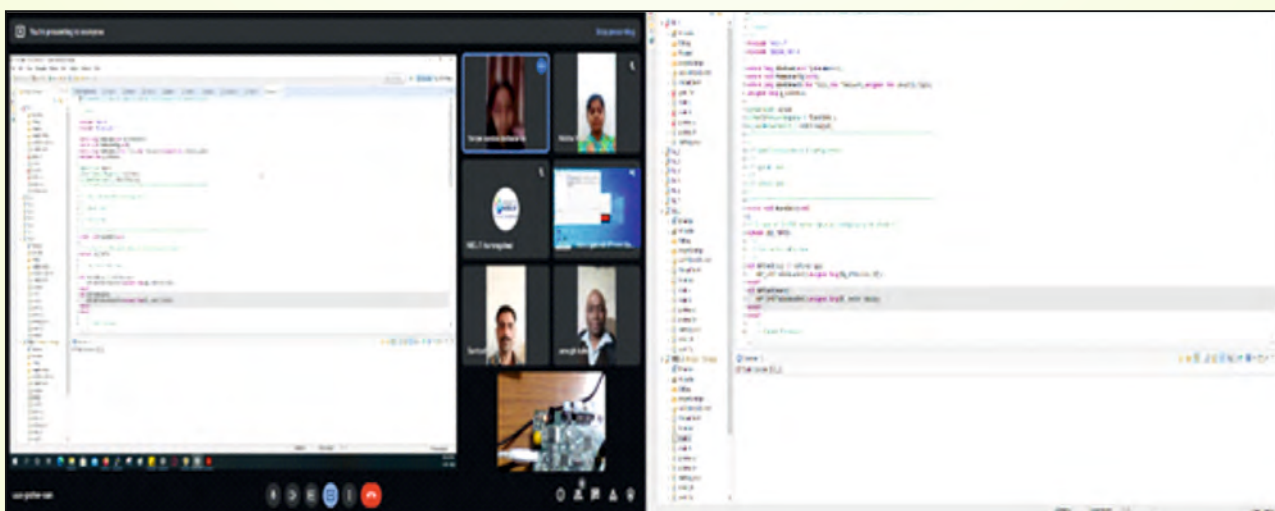
Training Program on Junior Software Developer

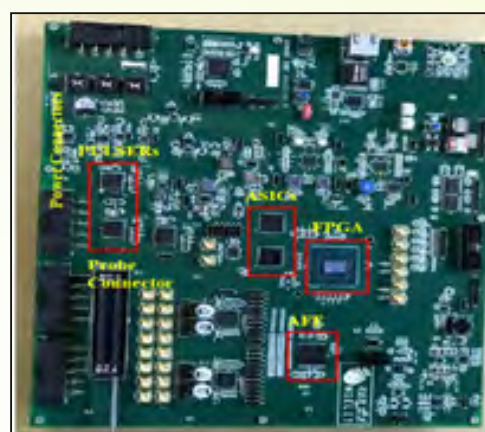

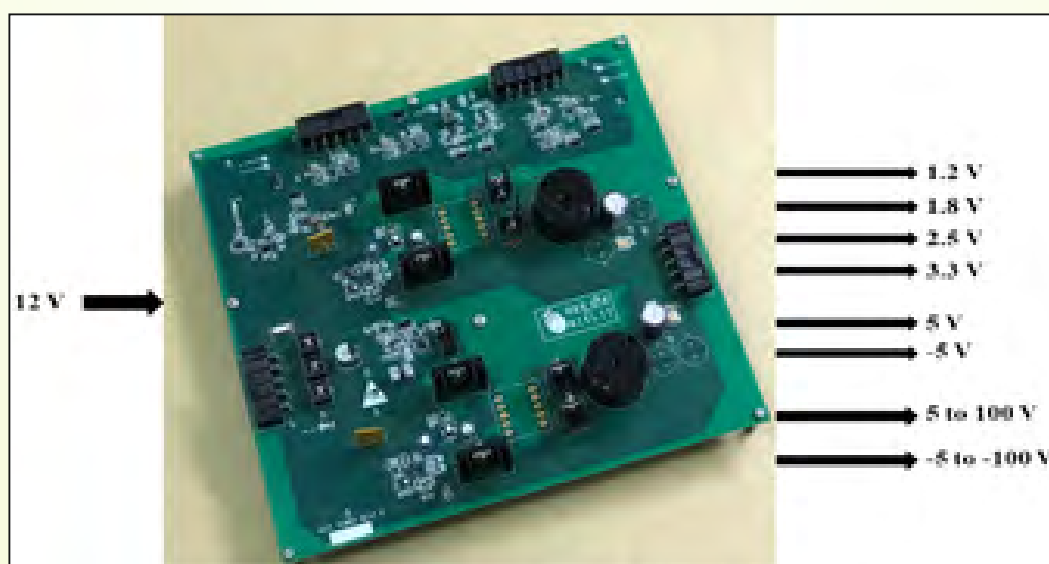
