
NIELIT Celebrates 75th Independence Day & Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsay

Soft Skills Training on Time Management





Webinar on Digital Marketing




• "e-Waste Management" for School Students



06 NIELIT Centers Inaugurated in Northeast







Webinars on Blockchain, Cyber Security and ARVR by NIELIT Chandigarh




Training Program for Defence Personnel of the Indian Army


Training on Packaging and Parcelling for Handloom and Handicraft Sector

Online Short-Term Training Program in PCB Design & Manufacturing



The internship programme was attended by students of different engineering colleges under Assam Science and Technology







Big Data Analytics



Cloud Computing




NIELIT Delhi centre conducted the Govt. officials training programme of two batches - National Academy of Broadcasting and Multimedia (NABM) and Border Security Force (BSF) under the FutureSkills PRIME project on Cloud Computing. Cloud Computing technology offers on-demand delivery of IT resources with a pay-as-you-go pricing model over the internet. Organizations can avoid the complexity of owning and maintaining their IT infrastructure. The training consisted of theoretical and practical aspects of using AWS and Openstack. A total of 61 participants have been trained under this project till now.

Social Media Analytics Cloud (SMAC)

Robotic Process Automation (RPA)





R&D Projects & Innovation

IoT Smart Switch Controller 5 Node Designed and Developed by NIELIT Aurangabad for Home Automation and Office Automation



A Prototype of IoT Smart Switch controller 5 Node has been designed and developed by NIELIT Aurangabad for Home Automation and Office Automation under the initiative and leadership of Mr. Saurabh Kesari, Sc./E 'C'. Smart light systems constitute automated ways to light up homes and offices thereby eliminating the need for traditional switches. Using the product the home or office appliances can be controlled wirelessly using a Wi-Fi or Bluetooth based android application and can see the real-time status of the appliances on the mobile app which can be utilised for energy saving & real-time monitoring of appliances. Some of the features include;

Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant support with their respective mobile apps (no additional Amazon echo dot or google assistant device is needed for controlling the appliances.)

Supports 5 loads each up to 400W

Opto-Isolated outputs, Over Voltage protection, Over current protection, output overload and short circuit protection & surge protection for safe working in harsh environments

Real-time status update, User friendly, easy to install & Safe to Handle

R&D Project at NIELIT Srinagar

NIELIT Srinagar got Approval for an R&D Project titled "Applied Research in Design and Development of Prediction of Nutrients (N, P, K) in soil using Color Sensor with GIS" by the Technical Committee. The project is sponsored by the Department of Science and Technology UT of J&K. The major aim of this research is to use a colour sensor for the detection of NPK, Nitrogen (N), Phosphorus (P) and Potassium (K) levels in the soil. The colour sensor's photodiode is designed to decide on the additional quantity of these nutrients that have to be added into the soil to increase soil richness and fertility. "Smart Soil Quality Predictor" is going to check the presence and the amount of three main nutrients which are nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium in the soil and manage the deficiency of particular nutrition by comparing standard absorption wavelength to observed one.

Industry/Academia Collaboration

NIELIT Guwahati Inked MoU with The Assam Down Town University






