

MINUTES OF THE 3rd MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS

COMMITTEE (NSQC) HELD ON 20th November, 2020

The third meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) under National Council of Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) was held on 20th November, 2020 through video-conferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Shri. Praveen Kumar, Chairman, NCVET and Secretary, MSDE. The list of participants is at Annexure-I.

At the outset, Shri. Praveen Kumar, Chairman, NCVET and Secretary, MSDE welcomed all the participants for the meeting. Ms. Sunita Sanghi, EM, NCVET welcomed the members and initiated the proceedings of the meeting.

AGENDA ITEM 1: CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE 2nd MEETING OF NSQC


The Committee approved the minutes of the 2nd meeting of NSQC held on 22nd September 2020.

AGENDA ITEM 2: ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE MINUTES OF THE 2nd MEETING OF NSQC

NSQC took note of the action taken. The status of conditionally approved files in the 2nd meeting of NSQC (under NCVET), with respect to compliance, is at Annexure II.

The matters that were discussed and a decision arrived at among the ATR are as under: -

Item No. 3 (II) (i): Automotive SSC: Two file of ASDC were approved subject to change in entry requirements. However the matter of exemption of experience from schools was raised after the 2nd NSQC and the same was brought for the scrutiny of NSQC. The matter with regards to exemption of schools from experience in entry criteria for the courses running in schools of Four wheeler service technician and Two wheeler service technician was scrutinized by NSQC and the exemption was granted only for such courses being taken up in schools, and not otherwise. The Chairperson was of the view that the entry requirement of these two qualifications may be altered accordingly, which was also concurred to by CEO ASDC. The same was agreed to by NSQC.



Item No. 4: Industry Validation required for qualifications: In continuation on the matter as discussed in the 2nd NSQC, EM highlighted that NCVET is in the process of setting up its own committees as institutions to establish and scrutinize Industry validation. The time taken for this was till February 2021 as highlighted by EM and agreed to by NSQC. Till then the system of having industry validations as per present norms would continue. However, in specific cases where the industry validations may not be possible at the same scale, the reasons may be given in writing by the sponsor, and the same would be examined by NSQC.

AGENDA ITEM 3: QUALIFICATIONS SUBMITTED FOR NSQF ALIGNMENT

Executive Member (SS) informed NSQC that 94 qualifications (66 new and 28 revised), received from 16th July 2020 to 30th September 2020 were being considered in the NSQC after following due process and scrutiny. She gave a brief snapshot of the qualifications being considered for NSQF alignment.

A consolidated statement of approval status of Qualifications considered in the 3rd meeting of NSQC is placed at Annexure III(A); the qualification wise status is at Annexure III(B). Specific details are as follows:

I. QUALIFICATIONS SUBMITTED BY CENTRAL MINISTRIES

i. **DGT:** 19 Qualification files from DGT were laid for approval of the NSQC, the breakup is as under: -

A. 5 QFs of Flexi MoU for Ordinance Factory Board: 5 Qualifications in the capital goods sector for the Ordinance Factory Board under the Flexi-MoU were placed for the approval of NSQC and same were approved without any changes.

B. 4 QFs of Craftsman Instructor Training Scheme: 4 Qualifications under CITS (Instructor training scheme of DGT) were approved by the NSQC.

C. 10 QFs - 5 Short Term Course(STC) & 5 Apprenticeship Training Scheme(ATS): 2 qualification files for Automotive sector under STC of DGT were laid before the NSQC and were approved.



3 STC files of Apparel sector, 2 ATS files from Environment sector and 3 ATS files from Textiles sector were discussed in the NSQC. NSQC was informed that in case of STC files from apparel sector, duplicate qualifications exist. DGT however informed NSQC that they have consulted the relevant SSC and they never raised any objection for the same. All 8 files of DGT were approved by NSQC.

Chairman, NSQC suggested that Qualifications for manufacturing and service of Electric Vehicles should be developed.

- ii. **Indian Navy:** 3 files of Indian Navy were discussed in the NSQC. NSQC suggested reducing the NSQF of 'Bell Diver' and "Surface Supplied Air Diver", to Level 5 from the existing Level 6. Indian Navy to submit the revised qualification files.

Qualification of 'SCUBA Diver' was approved without any change.

- iii. **NFDC:** 2 Qualification files with the name Chief Camera Assistant and Digital Video Editor of NFDC were placed for consideration of NSQC. These two files were approved.
- iv. **National Centre of Organic Farming, MoAgriculture:** 1 Qualification with the name "Organic Farming Promoter/Manager" was presented in NSQC and the same was approved.
- v. **Ministry of Environment:** 24 revised files of MoEF&CC were placed for NSQC approval. NSQC was informed that of these 24 files only 2 files had certain changes while remaining 22 files were submitted for extension of review date without any changes. The NSQC approved extension of all the 24 files till September 2023.
- vi. **NIELIT, MEITY:** A total of 4 revised qualification files, without any changes were presented for approval. NSQC approved all the 4 files. However, Chairman, NSQC pointed out that in sectors like IT, courses must be updated regularly.

iv. QUALIFICATIONS SUBMITTED BY SECTOR SKILL COUNCILS

- a. **Automotive SSC:** A total of 9 revised files were submitted by the SSC. 8 files were approved without any change, however one file namely "Automotive CNC machining technician" was conditionally approved subject to addition of experience of 2 years after 12th standard as an entry condition. The same was agreed by SSC Automotive and shall be




resubmitted after changes.

- b. Agriculture Sector Skill Council:** 6 qualification files were presented to NSQC and approved based on all necessary licensing and regulatory requirements are adhered by ASCI for training.
- c. Instrumentation SSC:** 4 files submitted were approved, subject to the condition that the SSC shall submit the Line Ministry concurrence before the same is uploaded on NQR. If objection is raised by the Line Ministry, the SSC shall have to come back for approval in the next NSQC.
- d. Sports SSC:** Two new qualification files submitted by the sports SSC were approved by NSQC without any changes.
- e. Healthcare SSC:** 4 new qualifications of Healthcare SSC related to AYUSH were placed before the Committee and the same were approved.
- f. PwD SSC:** 1 new qualification of SCPwD from PwD sector was placed before the Committee and the same were approved.

Further, the matter related to approval of several Qualifications adopted by SCPwD are due for approval was raised by CEO, SCPwD. In this regard, the committee was informed that a separate section/sector needs to be created in NQR for PwD, as SCPwD being a horizontal SSC adopts approved Qualifications of SSCs and map them accordingly with the type of disabilities. The Committee took the note of the matter and instructed to expedite the process of creating a separate sector (for PwD) in NQR and to place the pending Qualifications in the next NSQC.

AGENDA 04: APPRENTICESHIP IN OPTIONAL TRADE

A. Fast track approval of "Optional Trades Curricula" by providing exemption in NSQF norms.

NSDC submitted a proposal for deliberation and appropriate decision w.r.t exemptions from providing Industry Validation from multiple industry and Line Ministry approval for QPs for NSQF alignment of Optional Trade Curricula under NAPS program. After detailed discussion NSQC decided that in case where NAPS qualification placed for approval of NSQC is a combination of already approved qualifications, the industry validation and the line ministry approval shall not be mandatory. However, in case of fresh qualifications under NAPS, the approval shall be given as under experimental approval category and no funding shall be given till the qualification is NSQF aligned and approved by NSQC fulfilling all necessary conditions. Also,

the experimentally approved qualifications would be required to be resubmitted for approval of NSQC within 9 months, if not submitted in full shape at the beginning itself.

B. Relaxation of experience required in minimum eligibility criteria for becoming an apprentice for Optional Trades under apprenticeship training

This was submitted for deliberation and appropriate decision w.r.t exemptions from providing relaxation of experience required in minimum eligibility criteria for becoming an apprentice for Optional Trades under apprenticeship training. DGT suggested that a previous level certification can be included as part of the experience requirement. NSQC was of the view that there could be no blanket relaxation given to NAPS qualifications. The relaxation w.r.t experience required shall be considered on case to case basis and decision taken thereof in NSQC meetings.

C. APPROVAL OF NAPS FILE

Ford along with ASDC submitted a qualification named Vehicle Manufacturing Operations – An Integrated Approach to be run under apprenticeship program-optional trade.

Qualification file was placed for deliberation and appropriate decision of NSQC and to determine modalities for alignment and approval of files under NAPS in future.


The Chairperson was of the view that the qualification needs to be sent to PwD-SSC and DGT for scrutinizing the suitability of the qualification for serving the inclusion of gender and disabled, as well as the appropriateness to be run as the Apprenticeship program under NAPS. The file is to be brought to the next NSQC meeting after the review.

With respect to the modalities of approving NAPS file in future it was decided that if a qualification / trade exists under designated trade it will not be considered under optional trade.

For such qualifications, the notional hours should also indicate the duration in range of 6 months to 3 years as per the Apprenticeship Act.

AGENDA ITEM 05: VALIDITY OF NSQC DECISIONS FOR SUBMITTING BODY

NSQC was informed that it has been noticed that at multiple instances the submitting bodies fail to comply with the decisions of NSQC even after multiple communications by NCVET, it was therefore proposed that if a submitting body fails to comply with NSQC decisions repeatedly, the approval given by NSQC may be withdrawn.

NSQC was of the view that there is no need of a separate approval of this agenda point as NSQC is competent to change its decision wherever, whenever felt necessary.

AGENDA ITEM 06: LINE MINISTRY CONCURRENCE

NSQC was informed that line ministry concurrence is a mandatory criterion while considering qualifications for NSQF alignment as it establishes the validity, appropriateness and need of the qualification.

It is however noted that Line Ministries are not able to send their concurrence to the awarding body seeking so, in spite of a regular follow up by the Awarding body. This result in delaying of the process of NSQF alignment of qualifications as their compliance remains unfulfilled.

NSQC was of the view that in case of regulated sectors like health or aviation, the line ministry concurrence shall remain a mandatory criterion. In all other cases a four-week time shall be given to the line Ministries to indicate their concurrence, unless otherwise communicated by Line Ministry.


ADDITIONAL AGENDA:

1. HEALTH SSC

6 revised qualification files of health SSC which are under scrutiny were placed before NSQC. NSQC was informed that although SSC has complied with the comments of MoH&FW, the compliance in totality w.r.t comments is not yet done. Since SSC has been insisting that they have complied with the suggestions of MoH&FW and pursuant to the decision taken in previous NSQCs that comments of MoH&FW need to be complied with in totality, the matter was placed before NSQC for a decision. NSQC directed that it may be examined if the compliance has been done, and if not, comments of MoH&FW may be obtained.

2. 14 DGT FILES

14 files of DGT were placed for NSQC approval. It was informed to NSQC that the desk scrutiny of these files have been undertaken however the stakeholder consultation is still pending, Chairman, NSQC accorded in- Principle approval to these 14 files subject to these clearing the further scrutiny at NCVET. The details of these qualifications is at Annexure III (C).


